Dear Christ Life Ministries Family,

I am writing to give you an update from Christ Life Ministries. It's with a very happy heart, that is in awe of His awesomeness, His ways are not our ways and His thoughts are not our thoughts; that I share with you only a glimpse of what He's been doing.

This has been an incredible summer; we have three additional children in our care for multiple days each week and we have seen God do so much in their lives. One no longer has a fear of water and has made great strides in learning to swim. They ask on a regular basis if they can stay here and spend the night. They can't wait to come and will contact us repeatedly to verify that they are coming and when they arrive they do not want to leave.

When these precious ones are with us they receive Bible Truth Lessons 2 to 3 times a day; along with numerous times of prayer. In addition, their spiritual training they are receiving physical training and are learning new sports (swimming, roller skating and bowling).

One of the biggest blessings is that they no longer complain over anything that bothers them physical or emotional; instead they come, sit and ask that we pray. If they have fallen, they want to have hands laid on them and for prayer to be made. When the children first started coming about a year ago; they were amazed that the hurt went away after prayer was made, now they expect it. God is so awesome showing himself to these three. Please be in prayer for these three precious children from different families.

We have seen the Lord move during our recent mission trip. It seemed like a whirlwind of places to go and people to see. The first stop was in Louisville, KY on July the 18th, Schaumburg, IL on the 19th with day outreach trips to Brighton & Kenosha, WI, Arlington Heights, Des Plains, Mount Prospect, Prospect Heights, Rosemont, Elk Grove Village, Roselle, O'Hara, Franklin Park and Batavia, IL; then back to Kentucky on July 24th to Crab Orchard, Danville, Stanford and Lexington.





In Roselle while doing laundry we got to have church in the Laundromat with 9 people (3 children and 6 adults). Five out of the nine's mother language was Spanish; so, I got to use a bit of what I've been studying. How cool is that. It was awesome! They were all hungry to hear the message. My three children and I were simply doing a lesson on healing and deliverance; what I was reading and teaching pulled in the others attention and next thing I knew I was teaching the truths of God's Words to nine people in addition to my three. So, we had church right there. What a blessing to my soul to see so many precious one's feed on the Word and faces lighting up with the truth of God's Word. Our children gave away horses to the other children as mementos and we put gospel literature in their hands.

The Lord worked in the Laundry on this trip and a week later in Danville, KY we had church again at Dukes Laundry, it was an awesome time of talking about my Daddy's doings. This time we ran into a brother and sister in the Lord and we just had an awesome time talking about His goodness and healing came for the sister for her legs which was in a bad state and was scheduled for surgery.

In Elk Grove Village at Elk Grove Bowl the manager blessed us with two games of bowling for free for the whole family. Another opportunity for the Lord to minister, we got to lay hands on the manager and pray for him while he was working. The Holy Spirit awe struck him, his co-worker and the people waiting in line. There was such a peace and the glory of God was tangible.

What a lovely climax to the trip with healings at the revival meetings in Crab Orchard. Barbara came forward for prayer; she had been having tremendous difficulty walking without pain for the past few years. She was not disappointed the Word Healed her and she jumped, hopped, danced, walked and jogged through the church. After her celebration of what good things God had done for her, she returned to her seat but she wasn't through with receiving from the giver of life in abundance. She came back up excited like a child in a candy store wanting to have her hands touched too. She told us that she hasn't been able to feel anything in her hands for the past 6 months. Healing was commanded to be restored and with the tip of my fingernail, as lightly as I could, I gently ran my nail down her fingers and the inside of her hands. She wept for joy because she could feel the slightest of touches. How awesome is MY DADDY!

At the revival meeting we also had a gentleman named Noah come up asking that the pain in his hip be gone. Well the Lord blessed him with more than that. His hip had been deteriorating for some time and had to walk with devices and human assistants. The pain was commanded to leave in the name of Jesus Christ and it went. What joy he felt. But the Lord wasn't through with him, he was asked to sit on the front pew and his shoes were removed; one of his legs were shorter than the other which he knew was the truth for years. He wore a lift in his shoe to get them closer to even. Hands

were laid on his legs and the leg grew to the same length as the other and he went walking through the church without help or aid and his hips were straight and he no longer limped.
