What is security?

What about a good credit rating?

None of the things listed above would be considered sinful, but not any of them or even all of them put together can provide REAL SECURITY!

Real security, can only be found in a relationship with Jesus Christ.

We can lock doors at night or during the day, we could have a home security system but real security comes only from the Lord!

Our government can provide all manner of electronic devices that shield, sensor and zap, but only God can protect from terrorism.

"Trust in the LORD with all thine heart; and lean not unto thine own understanding. In all thy ways acknowledge him, and he shall direct thy paths." Proverbs 3:5-6

"O LORD, I know that the way of man is not in himself: it is not in man that walketh to direct his steps." Jeremiah 10:23

Remember back when you were a child 3 to 5 years old. Being small and everything else being so large you could experience fear, unless you were with the larger person whom loved you dearly. In him/her you put your faith and trust, and with him/her you were secure and protected. As you get older you should be able to know that you are even more secure with God than you were with your father or mother. Just as you loved your parents when you were young, you should now have a love for the Lord.

"There is no fear in love; but perfect love casteth out fear: because fear hath torment. He that feareth is not made perfect in love." 1 John 4:18
