

## Domine Dunamis

*I awoke on 6/26/16 around 3am with these words "Domine Dunamis". They were more than words, they were in my mind, in my mouth, in my spirit, in every part of my being. It was me thinking and speaking but it was the Holy Spirit pouring out through me this truth.*

*The previous day my Father (God) had been pouring into me these truths below.*

Domine = lord; master (used as a title of address);

Dunamis = Short Definition: might, power, marvelous works. Definition: (a) physical power, force, might, ability, efficacy, energy, meaning (b) plur: powerful deeds, deeds showing (physical) power, marvelous works. Word Helps: "Power through God's ability"

*Then my Father continued his lesson.*

You cannot live in this new life if you want to bring anything into life, it is only His life that brings forth manifestations of His power. It is not in the flesh, it is foreign to the flesh. The flesh must decrease if the power of the life of God shall be made manifest by His Spirit. I must decrease and He must increase, I must live by His faith and not mine. ([John 3:30](#) & [Galatians 2:20](#))

There isn't room for two lives in one body: death to self is the way to the life of Christ being manifested through us. Our human desires are a tremendous hindrance and curse to this new life. Human supremacy wanting to be someone, wanting to do something special; but not until we can cease can God increase.

Unbelief is external to the spiritual nature, for the spirit say, "I live by the faith of the Son of God." ([Galatians 2:20](#)) This Word is so effective, that we live it, we speak it, we act it and we think it. It is who we are.
