

## FREEDOM!!!

*AND he began to speak unto them by parables. A certain man planted a vineyard, and set an hedge about it, and digged a place for the winefat, and built a tower, and let it out to husbandmen, and went into a far country. And at the season he sent to the husbandmen a servant, that he might receive from the husbandmen of the fruit of the vineyard. And they caught him, and beat him, and sent him away empty. And again he sent unto them another servant; and at him they cast stones, and wounded him in the head, and sent him away shamefully handled. And again he sent another; and him they killed, and many others; beating some, and killing some. Having yet therefore one son, his wellbeloved, he sent him also last unto them, saying, They will reverence my son. But those husbandmen said among themselves, This is the heir; come, let us kill him, and the inheritance shall be ours. And they took him, and killed him, and cast him out of the vineyard. What shall therefore the lord of the vineyard do? he will come and destroy the husbandmen, and will give the vineyard unto others. And have ye not read this scripture; The stone which the builders rejected is become the head of the corner: This was the Lord's doing, and it is marvellous in our eyes? And they sought to lay hold on him, but feared the people: for they knew that he had spoken the parable against them: and they left him, and went their way. Mark 12:1-12 KJV <sup>1611</sup>*

Above speaks of the prophets that brought the truth and when God checked to see if what was told was obeyed, they beat and killed all the prophets and refused to accept the truth. We are held accountable to one God. When He sent His own Son with the truth, He too was rejected, beaten and killed. So He then took the message to others and presented the truth to a different people (aggressively done by His disciples after His death) the Gentiles - you and I.

But the Gentiles as a whole who claim Christianity but not the truth of the Father and the blood of Jesus Christ are they not the same as the husbandman? They have killed Him and the message in their hearts.

Beware of the itching ears and those who like to scratch and tickle them.

Many who call themselves Christians have become a mock of Christ. Many who claim things like I'm saved, sanctified and filled with the Holy Ghost and Fire. Wouldn't know the Holy Ghost fire it burned them. They give lip service of God's power but serve an impotent God which is lower than the local pharmacy, clinic, doctors office and old wives tales.

My God is not impotent, He is mighty. He is the same yesterday, today and forever. My God heals all who seek Him in Spirit and Truth. My God is still moved by compassion and doesn't want to see anyone in Satan's bondage. My God wants to set people FREE. FREEDOM!
