Pronunciation = Sue Sy **Susi**, "[my] horse": - Susi

1) grace

a) that which affords joy, pleasure, delight, sweetness, charm, loveliness: grace of speech

Greek 5483 – xapizouai, charizomai v. GK 5919 [>5463] -To give grace ; to forgive, cancel (a debt) ; to grant ; to hand over into custody ; forgave given, forgiven, deliver, forgiving, gave, frankly forgave, freely given, freely give, granted.

5463 Chairō - To rejoice, be glad, delighted (as a greeting) Hail!, Greetings! Rejoice, glad, rejoiced, rejoicing, joy, God speed, rejoiceth, farewell, joyed, joyfully, rejoicing greatly.

Father reveal to me what I'm supposed to understand in this?

Strong, graceful and powerful as a beautiful horse imparting forgiveness and freedom all with a joyfully rejoicing, great rejoicing in a God speed manner.

I can visualize it. How wonderful. The strong, powerful horse standing there [regal, elegant glistening in the sun. The sunlight reflects the etched outlines of his massive muscular frame. He all of a sudden starts galloping swiftly to a person on the other side of the field tied in ropes in bondage], he takes his teeth and rips the ropes off and sets

the person free. Then leaps around tossing his massive head back with his long mane blowing in the breeze; then kicks up his heels with sheer joy over the one set free.

Grace:

My son, be strong in the grace that is in Christ Jesus. 2 Timothy 2:1 KJV
