Jesus Christ willingly gave up His life so that you might have life, and He now asks that you give up your life and use it to glorify Him. Have you given yourself back to God as one who is dead to yourself so that He can transform your life and use you? Are you fully committed to God in all areas of your life?

Proverbs 16:3 Commit thy works unto the LORD, and thy thoughts shall be established.

Proverbs 3:5-6 Trust in the LORD with all thine heart; and lean not unto thine own understanding. In all thy ways acknowledge him, and he shall direct thy paths.

Romans 12:1 I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service.

Romans 6:13 Neither yield ye your members as instruments of unrighteousness unto sin: but yield yourselves unto God, as those that are alive from the dead, and your members as instruments of righteousness unto God.

Romans 6:11 Likewise reckon ye also yourselves to be dead indeed unto sin, but alive unto God through Jesus Christ our Lord.
