## Jesus Still Heals

Matthew 8:1-17 KJV – Read

Jesus said, "If you will ask anything in My Name I will do it, ask, it will be given, seek you will find; knock, it will be opened.

These signs will follow them that believe, in **My name they** (the believers) will **cast out demons**. They will **speak with new tongues**...

They will **lay hands** on the **sick** and they will **recover**.

The signs were to **follow** the believer.

This is the trademark of Christ.

It is the truth burned into the soul of the Believer with heavenly fire.

Baptism in the Spirit of Jesus was Christ reproducing Himself in the Believer.

The believer is expected to **heal the sick**.

<u>Lay hands</u> on the sick, <u>believe</u> and <u>allow Christ to manifest</u> himself in and through them.

People were not to die, they were to recover.

People are healed through the believers by the power of the Holy Spirit by Jesus Christ manifesting himself in and through the believer.

Professor A.B. Bruce, 'Miraculous Elements of the Gospel', "cures should be as common as conversion, and that Christ's healing miracles are signs that disease does not belong to the true order of nature and are but a prophecy that the true order must be restored to us."

There is a universal longing for such a faith for the healing and quickening of our mortal bodies as this.

<u>Genesis</u> tells us part of man's purpose <u>"Subdue & take dominion over every living thing."</u>

## The atoning sacrifice of Christ covers the physical, emotional and spiritual needs of the race.

God's covenant of healing with the children of Israel. A covenant is an unbreakable agreement, and can never be canceled.

God tested the nation of Israel at the waters of Marah and made a covenant with them, known as the Covenant of Jehovah Ra pha (The Lord, Thy Healer).
