I'm looking forward to this yearly remembrance of Jesus' passion and He is becoming the Passover Lamb.

Jesus became the Passover Lamb during the celebration of Passover. During the week of Passover there was much talk and remembrance of what happen in History.

When the Israelites were slaves in Egypt God used a man name Moses to deliver them from slavery and bondage.

As we look back into history we must see the significance of the history to the future. The slavery and bondage for us today is anything that separates us from God; from God's best.

Egypt was shown many plagues, there were significate because these were to demonstrate to us that nothing can separate us from God. It is to show us that if we abide in the Shadow [Psalm 91](#), He is our refuge, our hiding place and our salvation.

The last plague was most significant because of eating the Passover Lamb and the bread without yeast. This bread without yeast is showing us that all sin must be removed from our lives. But that when we put our trust in God and what he says then the Passover Lamb, Jesus, applies. The Israelites took the blood of a perfect lamb and painting it on the door frame of their dwelling place, then inside they ate the Passover Lamb and unleavened bread. This was significant because this lamb was pointing toward the future and the Passover Lamb that would take away the sin, sickness, disease and infirmities if we put our trust in Him.

Isaiah understood the truth of the Passover Lamb [Isaiah 53:5](#), he was looking into the future for the Ultimate Passover Lamb. Peter one of Jesus' disciples was looking into history and seeing the significance of the Passover Lamb when he said, "who his own self bare our sins in his own body on the tree, that we, being dead to sins, should live unto righteousness: by whose stripes ye were healed." [1 Peter 2:24](#).

Both understood the significance, that the Passover Lamb was for both sin and healing. After the Israelites ate the Passover Lamb they left Egypt and there wasn't any sick or feeble among them. [Psalm 105:37](#) When we trust without doubting God and do what He says, then we see results of that.

John the Baptist said "Behold, the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world!" Sin what an awful mess. From the beginning of the fall of mankind, when the first man

and woman sinned by disobeying God penalty, the debt was death and worldwide corruption. Thorns and thistles, sickness and disease came.

But Isaiah knew about the Passover Lamb and John shared what He, Jesus, was for. "For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life." [John 3:16](#) He paid the debt He did not owe, we owe debt we cannot pay we need Him to come and renew / fix our relationship with God.

So now if you have accepted Jesus Christ as Savior and Lord, God now sees you through His Son.

What an awesome time of year this is. When we get to remember, and come to an understanding of what the significance of our Passover Lamb is for our lives.
