

## Premeditated Murder

*Premeditated:*

*Definition: think out or plan (an action, especially a crime) beforehand.*

*synonyms: planned, [intentional](#), [deliberate](#), preplanned, [calculated](#), [cold-blooded](#), [conscious](#), prearranged*

Premeditated self murder is suicide.

Suicide does not equal heaven.

Sin will not be found in heaven. ([Revelation 21:27](#))

*And there shall in no wise enter into it any thing that defileth, neither whatsoever abomination, or maketh a lie: but they which are written in the Lamb's book of life." Revelation 21:27*

It is a nice thought for our flesh that people who commit murder would go to heaven but that is not what God's Word says. ([1 Timothy 1:8-10](#) & [Revelation 21:7-8](#))

*"But we know that the law is good, if a man use it lawfully; knowing this, that the law is not made for a righteous man, but for the lawless and disobedient, for the ungodly and for sinners, for unholy and profane, for murderers of fathers and murderers of mothers, for manslayers, for whoremongers, for them that defile themselves with mankind, for menstealers, for liars, for perjured persons, and if there be any other thing that is contrary to sound doctrine;" 1 Timothy 1:8-10*

*"He that overcometh shall inherit all things; and I will be his God, and he shall be my son. But the fearful, and unbelieving, and the abominable, and murderers, and whoremongers, and sorcerers, and idolaters, and all liars, shall have their part in the lake which burneth with fire and brimstone: which is the second death." Revelation 21:7-8*

Yes, this hurts our hearts to know that someone you love will spend eternity in hell. Yes, it can be painful to know this and many tears will be shed but God's Word also tells us that He will wipe away all tears. This is part of the reason there are tears to wipe away. ([Revelation 7:17](#) & [Revelation 21:4](#))
