

Living in the Spirit

2 Corinthians 3:10-11 For even that which was made glorious had no glory in this respect, by reason of the glory that excelleth. For if that which is done away was glorious, much more that which remaineth is glorious.

God showed me, people are living on the Commandments, “X” amount of Articles of their denomination, infant baptism, and all kinds of rituals. The Lord showed me that all these things have to be done away with.

There is no place in the deeper plan with God without absolutely putting them to one side. “Done Away With”.

Is it possible to do away with the commandments? Yes and no. If they are not done away with, that you have no consciousness of keeping them, then they are not done away with. The old things are done away with. If there is any worry or trouble in you, it shows you have not come to the place where you are at rest, at peace in Him.

God helps us to see the truth. If this teaching is too deep from some of us, I pray that you would ask the Lord to open your eyes to it. There is no one that has power in prayer or has power in life with God, if they are trying to keep the commandments.

The very going away of the commandments deeper fixes them into our hearts than ever before. Out of the depths of our hearts we cry to God, and in the depths He puts righteousness in and uncleanness out. May God lead us every step of the way in His divine leading.

Galatians 2:20 I am crucified with Christ: nevertheless I live; yet not I, but Christ liveth in me: and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by the faith of the Son of God, who loved me, and gave himself for me. (Oh, if we could truly grasp the truths of this Scripture.)

Is it Christ living in and through us or are we [still walking in the carnal man](#), with the carnal thinking ([stinking thinking](#))?

Romans 8:6 For to be carnally minded is death; but to be spiritually minded is life and peace. (Oh to have this peace is priceless.)

Romans 7:11 For sin, taking occasion by the commandment, deceived me, and by it slew me.

Romans 7:5 For when we were in the flesh, the motions of sins, which were by the law, did work in our members to bring forth fruit unto death.

Galatians 5:22-23 But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, gentleness, goodness, faith, meekness, temperance: against such there is no law. (Oh, the sweet fruits; taste and see how sweet they are.)
